

2022 Open Enrollment

Open enrollment begins on November 1st for coverage beginning January 1, 2021. Open enrollment is a period of time when you can enroll for health insurance or change your existing plan. Open enrollment ends on January 15, 2022, but enrollment must be completed by December 23, 2021 for a January 1, 2022 effective date. Enrollments completed after December 23, 2021 will have a February 1, 2022 effective date.

New Mexicans will have health insurance options through Friday Health Plans, True Health New Mexico, Molina, Blue Cross Blue Shield of New Mexico, Presbyterian, and Ambetter. If your income is at or below 138% of the Federal Poverty Level (approximately \$17,616 for a single person household or \$36,156 for a family of four), you may be eligible. Visit <u>www.yes.state.nm.us</u> to apply.


